



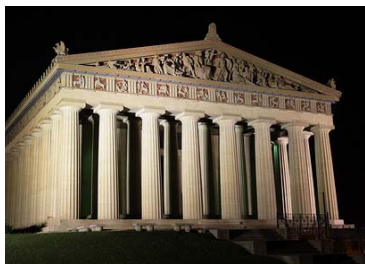

- **Visit Belle Meade Plantation** – Visit this historic 30-acre historic site conducted by period, costumed interpreters. The centerpiece of the property is the Belle Meade Mansion built in 1853. The farm was a thoroughbred nursery famous for breeding and training championship race horses.
- Welcome aboard the **General Jackson Showboat** for an unforgettable night! This 300-foot paddlewheel riverboat cruises the Cumberland River offering fantastic live shows and great meals.
- **Country Music Hall of Fame** – This museum presents the crown jewels of its vast collection to illustrate country music's story as told through the turns of two centuries. A collection of historical costumes, memorabilia, instruments, photographs, manuscripts and other objects tell the story of Country Music.
- **Grand Ole Opry Show** – The American icon and Nashville's number one attraction showcases the best in Country and Bluegrass Music from new artists, superstars and legends.
- **Cut a record on Music Row** – Visit the **Historic RCA Studio B** – Participate in a recording session with the Everly Brothers. This is where Elvis recorded more than 200 hits.
- **Nashville Haunted Ghost** - Walk - As skies begin to darken over the city of Nashville, students will learn about the spirits that haunt notable Nashville landmarks such as the Tennessee State Capitol, President Polk's Tomb, Ryman Auditorium, Printer's Alley and so much more!



- **Visit Bicentennial Capitol Mall State Park** - Tour Tennessee via a 200-foot granite map of the State, a walkway featuring the 95 counties, 31 fountains representing the major rivers of Tennessee and an extraordinary wall depicting the history of the State.

- * **Ryman Auditorium** - Built in 1892, the Ryman Auditorium is a 2,362 seat live performance venue and National Historic Landmark... a must see for anyone visiting Nashville. Most famous as the historic home of the Grand Ole Opry from 1943-1974, the Ryman is the very epicenter of Music City.
- * **Nashville Shores Outdoor Water Park** - The Park features nine waterslides, including the Music City Racer, three pools, a beach, lake cruises, miniature golf, kayaks, the Giant Bucket of Fun and much more!
- * **The Parthenon** - Take your group to the Parthenon, the world's only full scale replica of the classical era's crowning achievement, located in a Centennial Park just a few miles west of downtown Nashville.
